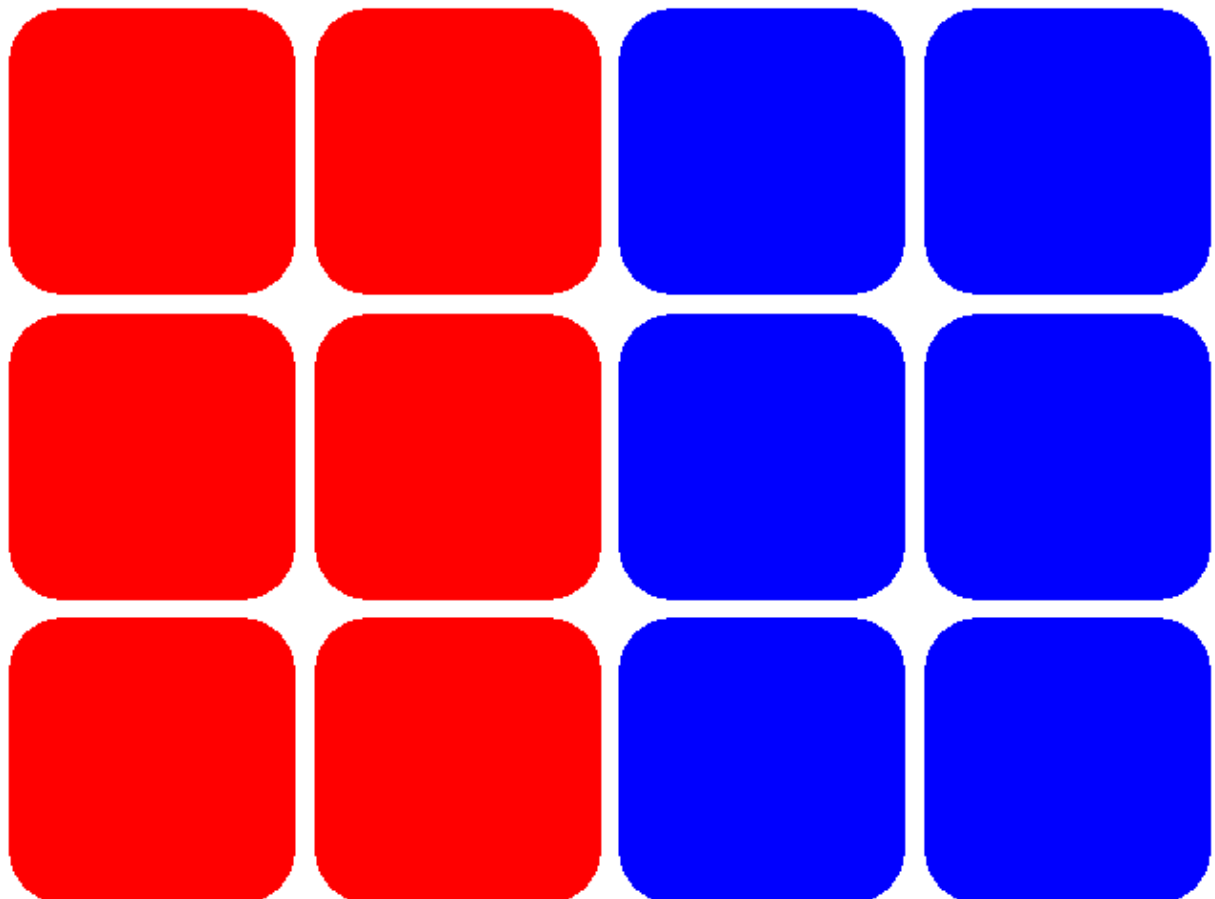


Colour Games – Red and Blue

These games will help to develop children's concepts of red and blue.

- Red and Blue Counters
For this activity, cut the counters out and help your child to sort them into red and blue.



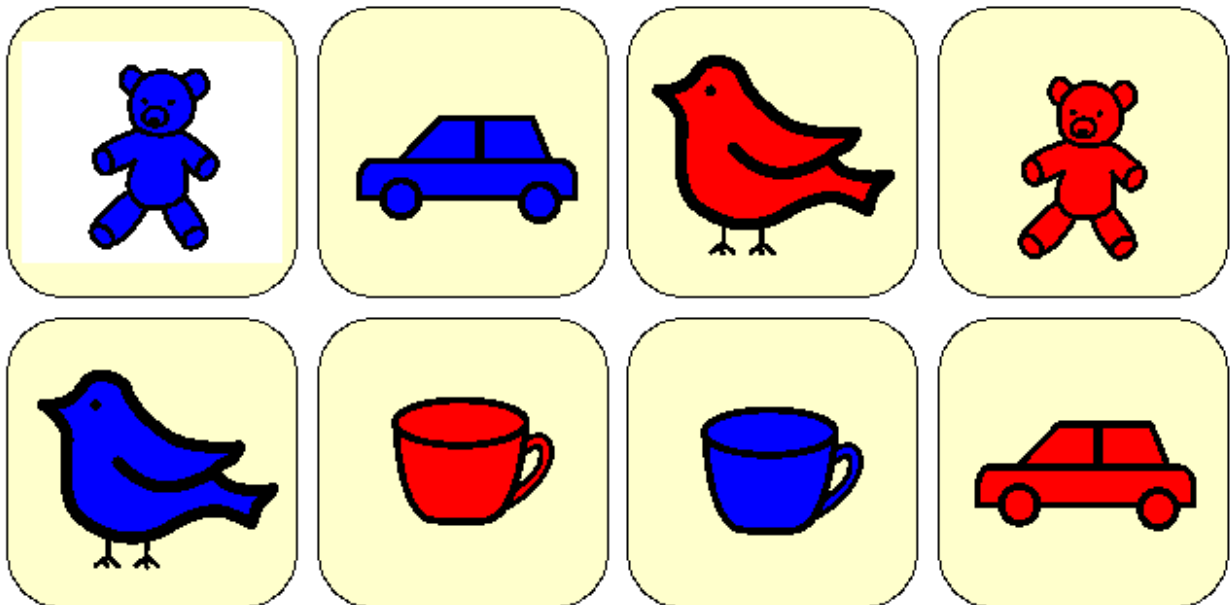
- Lotto Game 1

For this activity you will need to print off two copies of the lotto board. You will need to cut up the pictures below from one copy and you will need to give your child the other lotto board.

Present your child with a picture one at a time and you can either
- get them to match them up, commenting on the colour of the item and what it is, e.g. "it's a red bird"

Or

- ask them to find 'the red bird' etc



- Lotto Game 2

For this activity you will need to print off two copies of the lotto board. You will need to cut up the pictures below from one copy and you will need to give your child the other lotto board.

Present your child with a picture one at a time and you can either
- get them to match them up, commenting on the colour of the item and what it is, e.g. "it's a red t shirt"

Or

- ask them to find 'the red t shirt' etc
