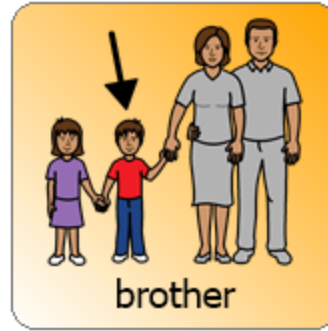
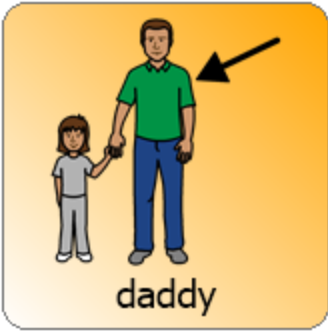
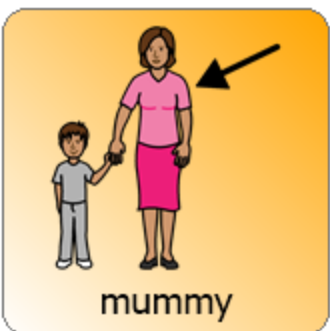
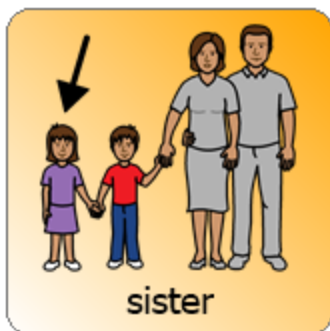
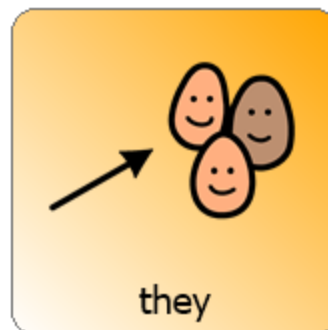
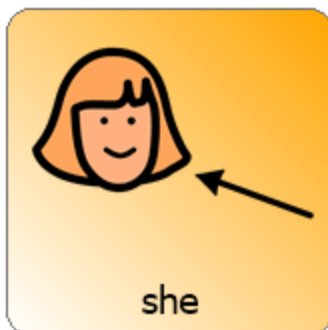
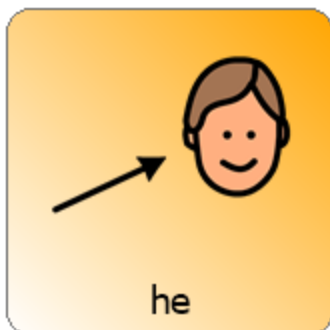
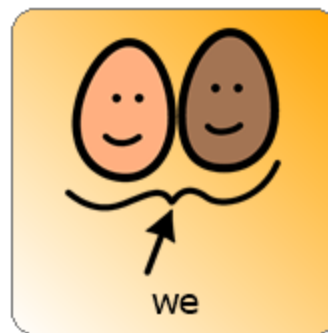
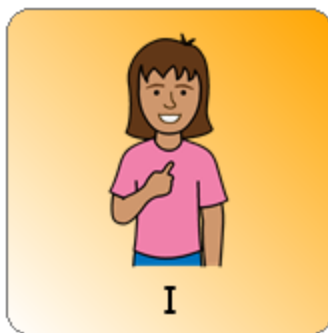
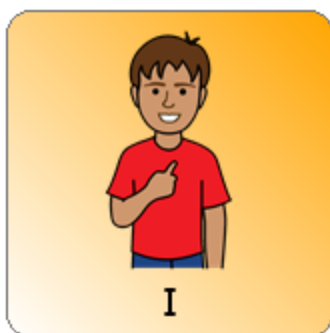


Colourful Semantics - winter theme

'did you decorate your house?'

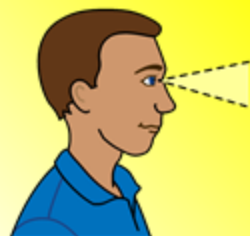
