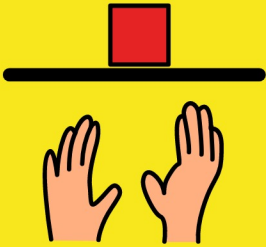
Leaving School/a Class

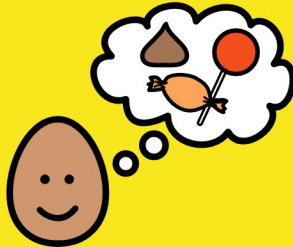


You can prompt them by asking questions such as:- Where are you going? Who will you miss? - When do you leave? - Why are you leaving? How do you feel?

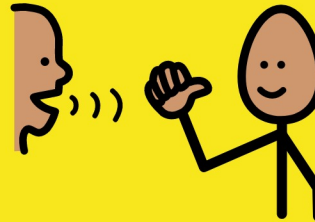




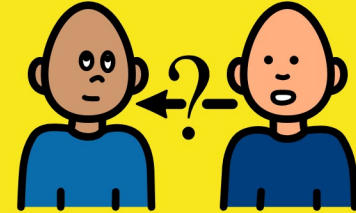
