'what did you eat?'

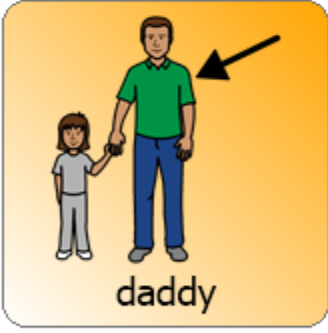
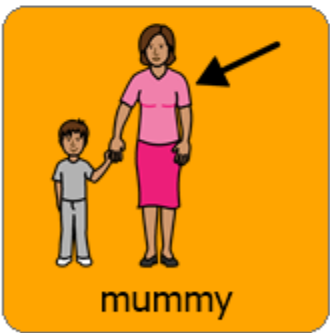
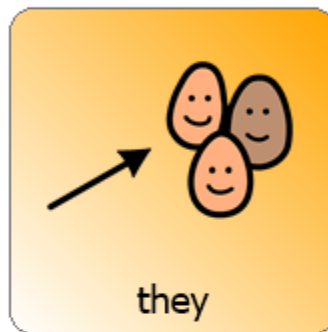
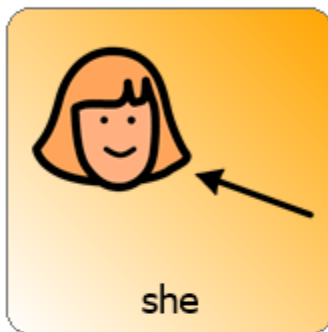
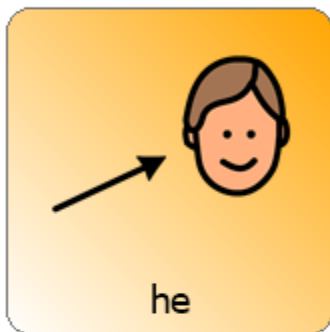
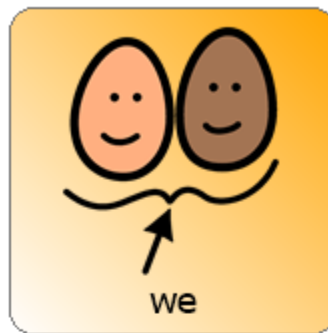
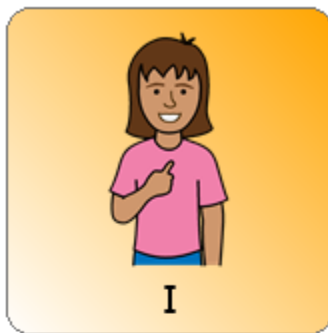
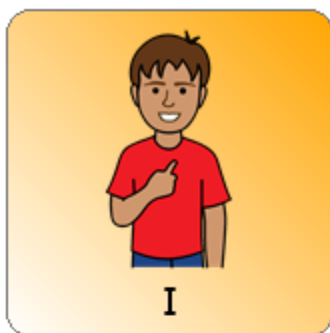
