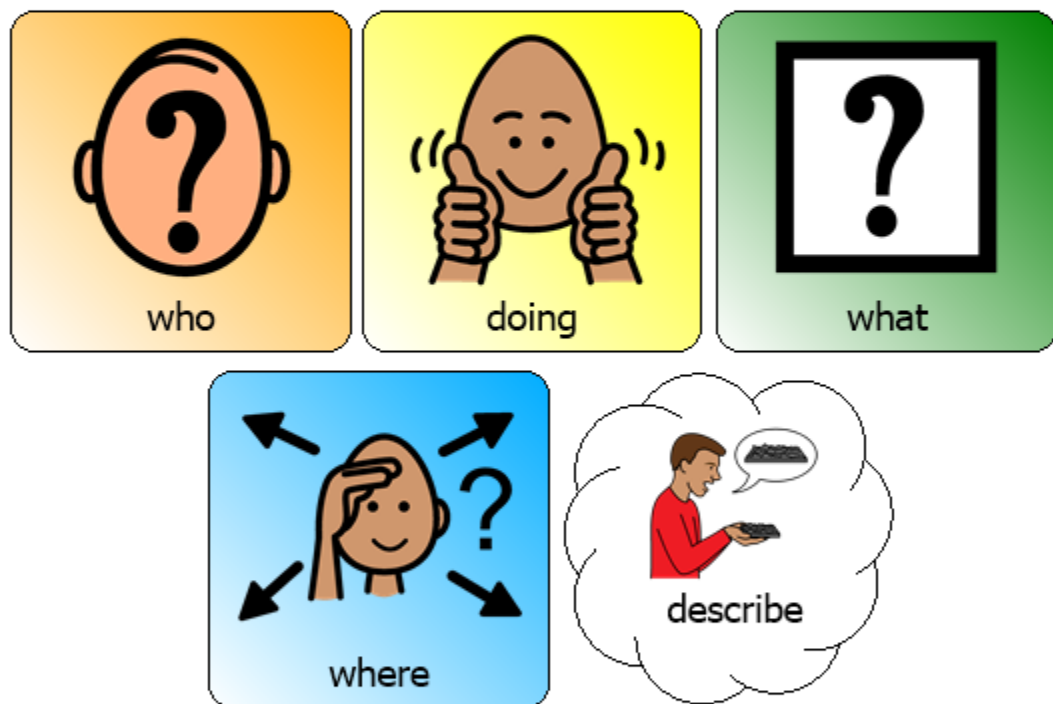


Colourful Semantics - The Polar Express
