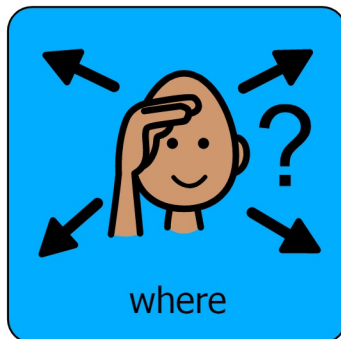
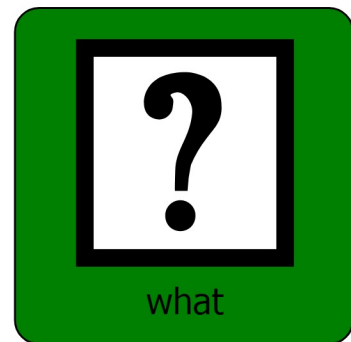


# Colourful Semantics - Oracy & Reading Comprehension Pack
