


Marvin the Monster has big muscles. He is strong. He can carry HEAVY things

Little Lionel is not strong. He can't carry heavy things... he can carry LIGHT things.


Marvin and kionel go shopping together...





LIGHT things float on top of the pond.




The hot air balloon is getting ready to float away.




Here comes the tractor to pull the trailer along. Draw lines from the trailer to the HEAVY things around it. Only the HEAVY things go in the trailer








... but when Heavy Harry sat in the boat ....






So, Heavy Harry and Lizzie Light decided to go to Monster Park.

Heavy Harry sat on the see-saw. "Now you get on Lizzie;" said Harry...






... but the see-saw didn't go up and down! "You're too light Lizzie", said Harry.


They thought very hard about what they could do! "Let's have a go in those not air balloons!" said Lizzie Light.
